Competition Guidelines

1. Each school may have one entry per category.
2. A club may enter only one (1) item per category, however an individual student may enter more than one category.
3. Entry must be the work of only the Beta Club member entering it.
4. Students may not submit an entry which has been entered at a previous state Beta convention. All entries must have been created within the current year.
5. Students must attend convention in order to compete in this category.
6. Art tags are included on the following page. Print, complete in full and attach to the back or bottom of the entry. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility to be judged.
7. Although reasonable precautions to protect entries will be taken, the National Beta Club will not be responsible for loss, damage or breakage. It is the responsibility of clubs entering the competition to collect entered items only at the designated times.
8. Judging will be done by consensus of the judges. There will be no judging sheets.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Creativity - Originality, innovation

Composition - Lines, balance, color contrast, details

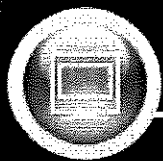
Focus - Degree of sharpness or softness, depth of field

Technique - Paint strokes

Primary visual impact

Presentation - Appearance, complimentary framing and/or mounting, overall artistic appeal

CATEGORIES (No kits allowed)

1. **Digital Art** - May include, but not limited to logo design, graphic design, architectural design, drafting, digital photography
2. **Fiber Arts** - work in basketry, crochet, fiber, knitting, needlework, papermaking, quilting, sewing, wearable art, and weaving
3. **Drawing** - Drawn with pastels, pen, ink, pencil, charcoal
4. **Mixed Media** - 2-Dimensional art using 2 or more art media
5. **Painting**
6. **Recyclable Art** - Use recyclable materials to create artwork
7. **Sculpture** - 3-Dimensional handmade pottery and/or ceramics, metal work, iron work, etc.
8. **Watercolor**
9. **Woodworking**
10. **Photography** - Black & White, color
